COMMUNITIES IN MOTION TIMELINE & ACTIVITIES

Winter 2003 - Summer 2004

Set goals for regional process

- Board establishes vision for process
- Community provides input for project

The Idaho Transportation Department and four rural counties join planning process

- Public involvement activities for the project continue
- Refine process and schedule for project



Fall 2004 - Summer 2005

Two sets of workshops, open houses, and numerous community presentations give the public an opportunity to identify:

- Land use preferences
- Transportation system improvements

Land use scenarios are presented to the public

COMPASS Board evaluates scenarios and selects a preferred land use (Community Choices)

Fall 2005 - Spring 2006

Open house public meetings to review transportation options for Community Choices and compare to Trend

Communities in Motion, the Regional Long-Range Transportation Plan, will be drafted

Open houses meetings/hearings will be held in Winter 2005-06 to review draft

The COMPASS Board will adopt *Communities in Motion* in Spring 2006
